Meningococcal Disease includes all invasive disease caused by *Neisseria meningitidis*, not just meningitis.
Animal rabies is not included.
PID is Pelvic Inflammatory Disease. Resistant Gonorrhea includes PPNG, penicillinase producing *Neisseria gonorrhoeae*, a form of gonorrhea which destroys penicillin, and CHRNG, chromosomally mediated resistant *Neisseria gonorrhoeae*, a form of gonorrhea which is resistant to penicillin.
