The totals for the State and each of its counties agree with the projections released by the Department of Economic Security (DES) on March 31, 2006 (<http://www.workforce.az.gov/?PAGEID=67&SUBID=138>). The percentages of population breakdowns by single-year of age, gender and race/ethnicity were derived from the "Bridged-Race Vintage 2006 Postcensal Population Estimates for Calculating Vital Rates", available from the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS: <http://www.cdc.gov/nchs/about/major/dvs/popbridge/datadoc.htm#vintage2006>). These percentages were then applied to total state and county population projections for 2007 from DES.
